

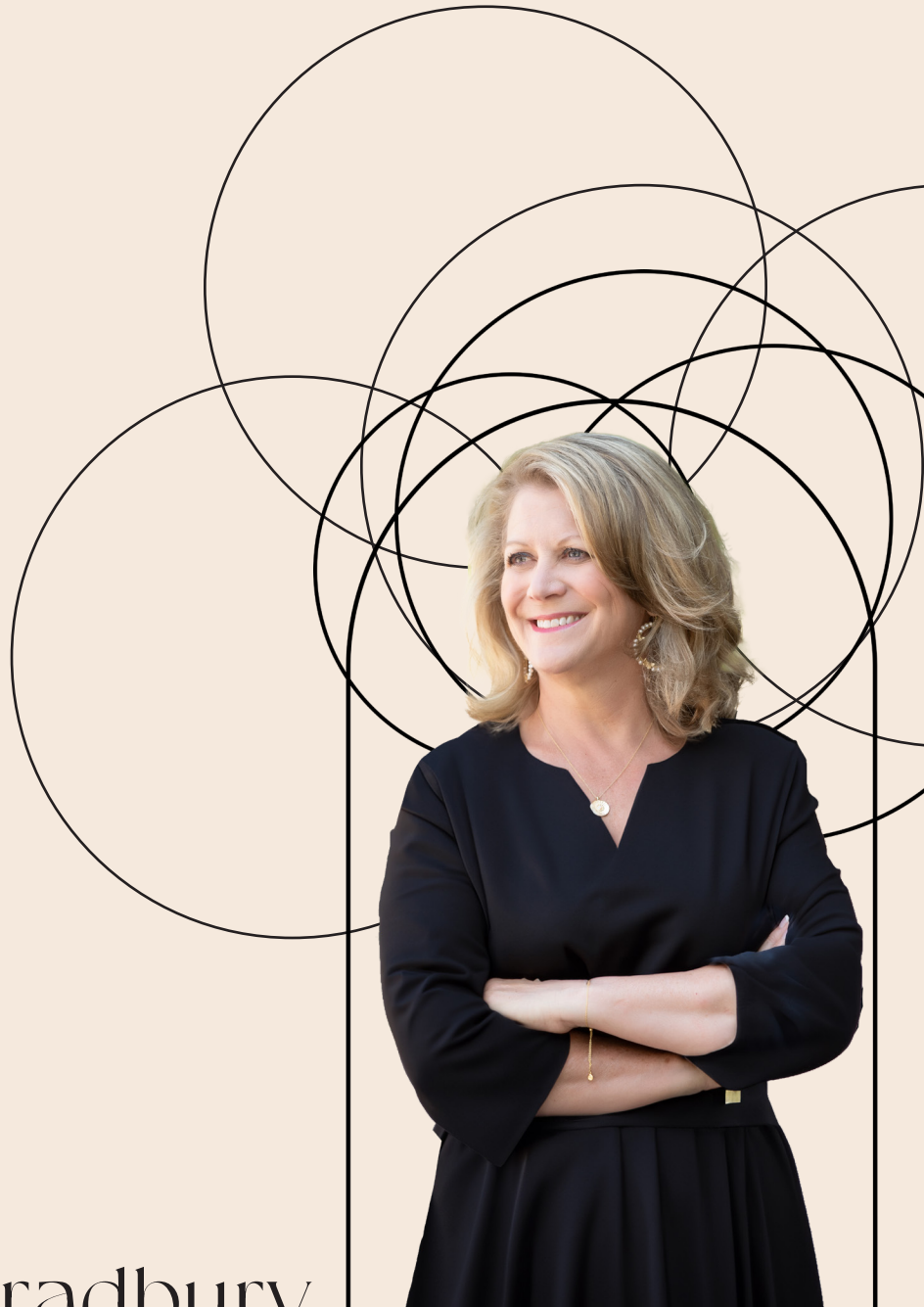

As a society, we are overwhelmed with the number of needs in our communities. Often, we become burdened by the magnitude and feel like there's just no place for us to do any good. I felt the same way.



As a former middle school teacher and mother of three daughters, I have always been passionate about kids. While I strongly connected with all kids, I was drawn to those who might not have had an easy life--especially teens. Just as I was becoming an empty-nester, I went through a divorce. Suddenly I was thrust into "needing" a job. My youngest daughter brought the subject of sex trafficking to my attention, shattering my rose-colored glasses and plunging me into a new sector of education.

I helped start a therapeutic day school for girls in the Denver metro area who had been exploited and/or trafficked, ultimately becoming the Director for three years. Recognizing that there was so much I didn't know I returned to school, obtaining my masters in social work and specializing in violence and injury prevention and sex trafficking. Then, I moved back in with my parents and became the primary caregiver for my elderly mother until she passed away in May 2023.

While I made a career of working with kids, I found that my approach to finding my service passion to change the world is transferable to helping others find their service passion to change the world. In the midst of the chaos, I also found transferable skills for changing setbacks into successes! I would love to help you and your group on your journey to change the world!
